

## Chart of Account (COA) Key Facts

Mandatory Segments - Required for all transactions					
Entity	Net Asset Class	Financial Unit	Account	VU_Function	
A academic, administrative or other that owns assets, liabilities and net assets (e.g., Blair School of Music, Human Resources, Public Safety)	Indicates:  *Use of funds  *Level of restriction for net assets (e.g., unrestricted, temporarily restricted)	An area whose activities generate revenues and/or incur expenses  Corresponds with Work Unit in the Organizational Structure	Describes the nature of the transaction (e.g., revenue, expense, asset, liability)	A functional classification to group expenses according to the purpose for which the costs are incurred.	

Optional Segments - User determined locally				
Program	Activity			
•A set of related activities	A specific event or activity			
•Typically are long-standing initiatives				

System-Generated Segments - No additional entry required			
InterEntity	Future 2		
Assigned by the system automatically when a transaction occurs between two Entity segment values	Reserved for future use


